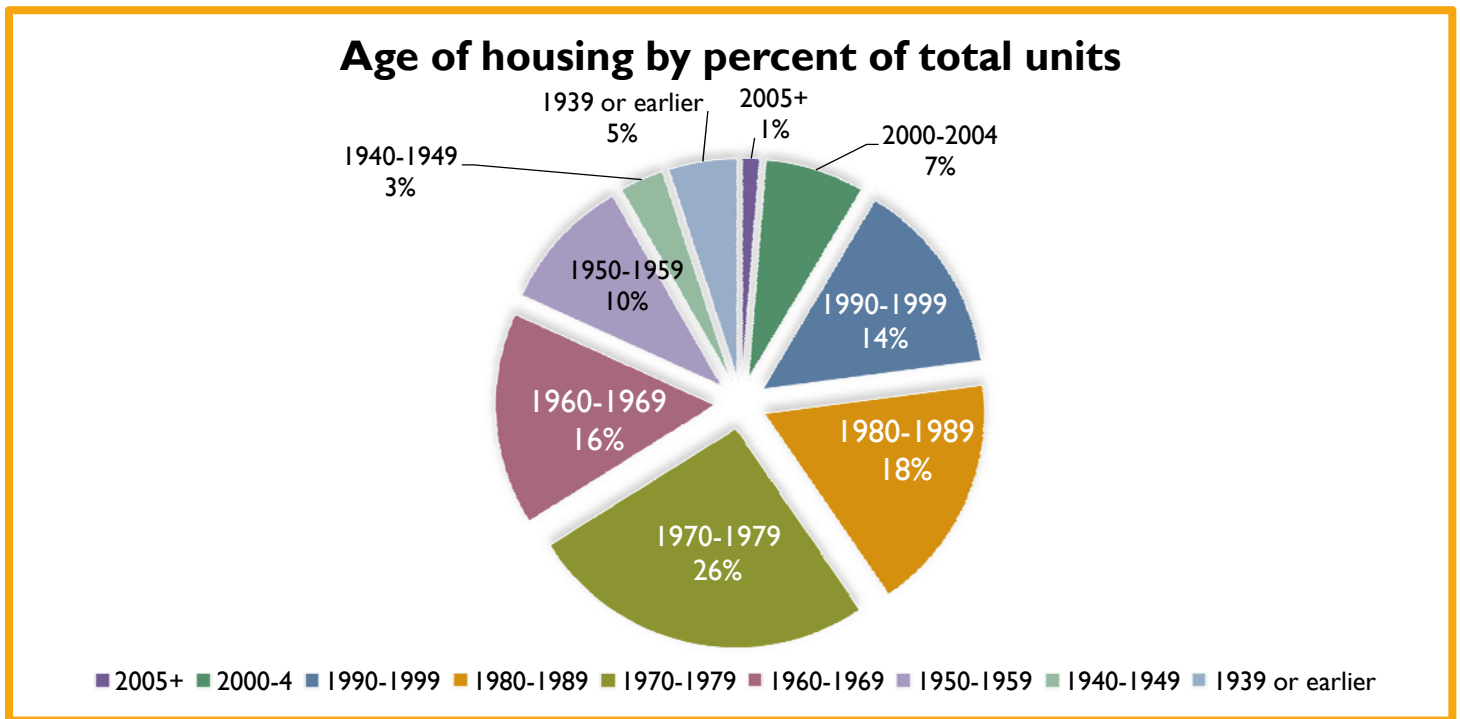
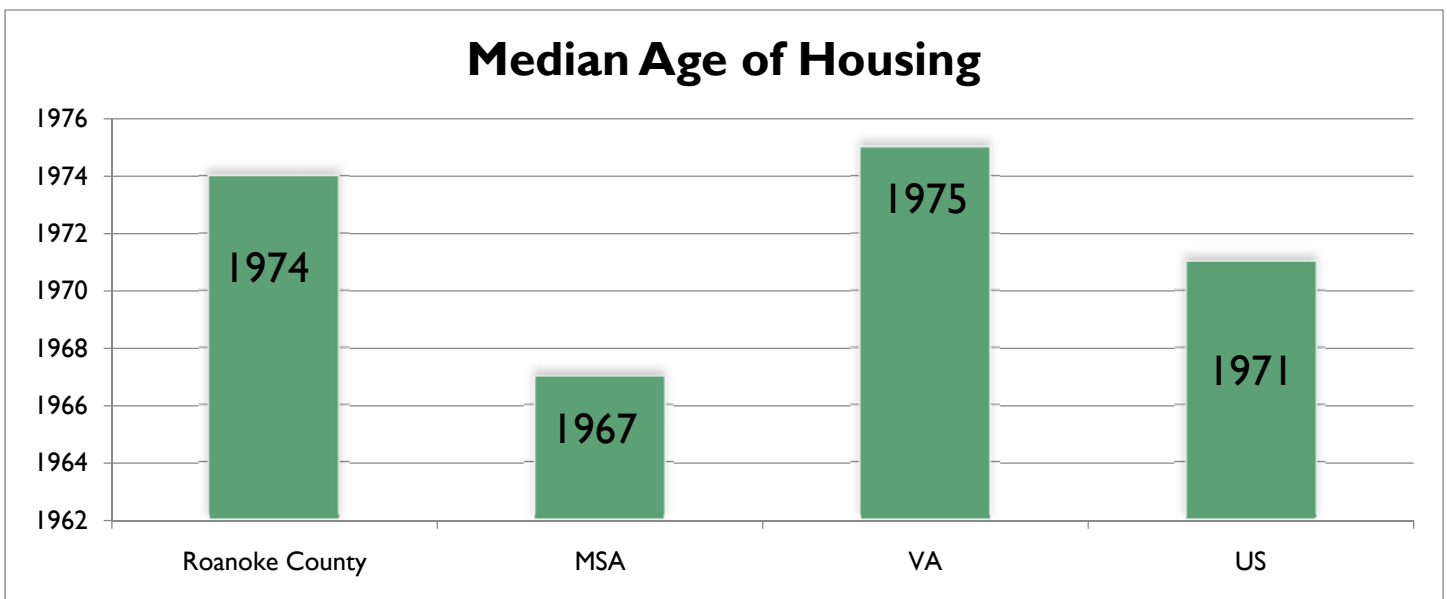


## Three quarters of Roanoke County's housing was built between 1960 and 1999



The above chart indicates that households in Roanoke County occupy a wide variety of houses built from prior to 1939 to after 2005. While no decade shows that the majority of houses were built within that period, 58% of housing was built between 1960 and 1999. Half of the county's housing was built between 1960 and 1989, with a quarter of the county's housing being built in the 1970s.



Data taken from the 2000 Census indicates that the median age of housing in 2000 was 1964. The age of housing in Virginia is one year newer; however, the age of housing in the MSA is significantly lower. This can be attributed in part to the inclusion of Roanoke City's historic districts in the regional data.
